- Use for sealing connection joints and filling cracks or screw/nail holes in walls and ceilings.

DIRECTION FOR USE

All surfaces must be clean and free of dust, chalk, oil, grease, wax, polish, mold and mildew stains, rust, loose material and all other foreign substances. Using proper safety precautions, cut the tip at a 45° angle to desired bead size. Apply with conventional hand or air-powered caulking equipment in a continuous operation with adequate pressure to fill the joint to the proper width and depth (do not overfill the joint). Gun sealant into void to provide a solid fill. Use backer rod for gaps larger than 1/2" x 1/2". Smooth using a dry tool or a slightly wet spatula if necessary. Allow 1 hour for sealant skin to form before painting with a brush/roller, or spray paint immediately. When finished be sure to remove and clean up all excess wet sealant with a damp sponge before it skins over. Excess dried sealant must be cut or scraped away. Reseal cartridge for storage and reuse.
